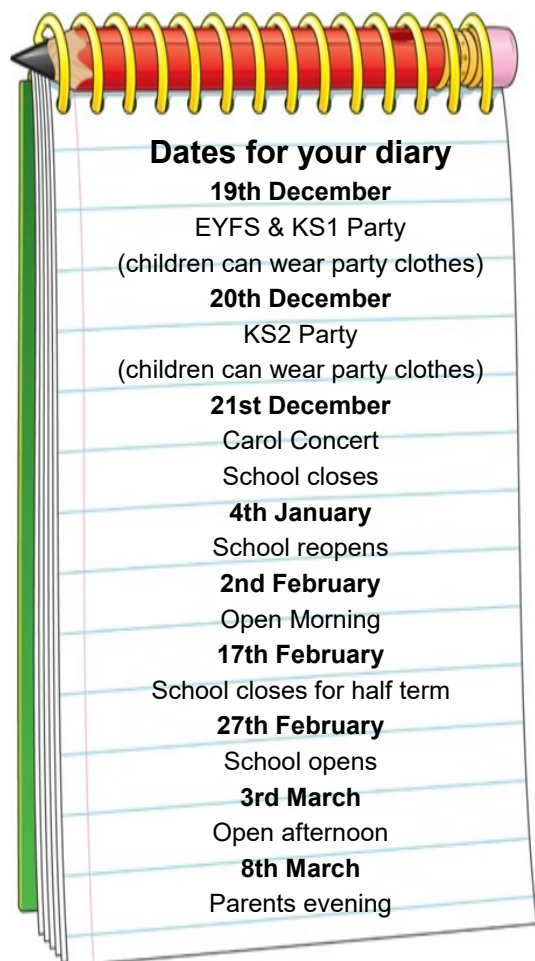

You said...	We responded:
Could we have more afternoon activities with extra work to make sure the children don't fall behind?	School does undertake interventions with children during the school day. We tend to use after school clubs to give children a more broad and balanced curriculum. However it is something that school will discuss
Can we have more updates on Instagram?	Absolutely! We do try and put as much on our Instagram as possible—but there is always room for some more!
Is it possible to have the donations for non-uniform through the school app?	Payments of less than £1.00 cannot be made on myevolvehub and non-uniform day is usually 50p per child.
Concerns raised around the website	We are currently negotiating an uplift for the website. We acknowledge that it does need a bit of work!
Nursery and reception clubs	Towards the summer term this may be possible. In the first term of school we find that a lot of our children are tired and an extra hour in clubs would not really be conducive. However there is also Clifton Owls for those parents who need the wrap around care options.
More information sharing between school and parents	We do try and give parents as much notice and information as possible. We have taken to using our newsletter to give a termly 'dates for your diary' to give as much notice as possible. We send texts and push notifications too. But as a school we will endeavour to make this more informative for you.
No more letters / newsletters being sent home. Go paperless	We rarely send letters / newsletters home these days. But sometimes we do need to try and capture all our parents and we do this through a variety of means.
Can I be made more aware of the interventions my child is having so I can support?	Yes. IEP's are always shared at parents evenings so parents can support. But we can look to share this information even earlier.
